DESCRIPTION

Getting an early gender DNA test can be a fun activity for you, your family and friends! Especially as you make plans and get ready for your new baby.

Our Gender Reveal test analyzes a simple blood draw sample to determine the gender of your unborn child. This test can be offered to new moms as early as 6 to 7 weeks into gestation, but to ensure the best results 8 weeks are recommended. This test can only be used for single pregnancies. This non-invasive prenatal test (NIPT) test has accuracy above 99%. This test analyzes the fetal DNA that circulates in maternal blood.

WHY DO I NEED THIS TEST?

If you are curious about the gender of your unborn child prior to getting your customary 20-week ultrasound.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE TO GET MY LAB TEST RESULTS?

Test results will be reported in 3 to 4 business days.

AM I REQUIRED TO FAST FOR THIS LAB TEST?

No fasting is required.
